ACLS Experienced Provider Course

An ACLS EP course has been scheduled for October 18, 2014 from 8:00a-5p at the Franklin Center, 50 Claiborne Ave, Rocky Mount, VA 24151. Course fee is \$125. Fee does not include the course manual which is required. *Students must have a current ACLS and BLS Provider Card*. Seating is limited. Pre-Registration and course fee must be received by October 3, 2014.

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

The ACLS Experienced Provider course is designed for experienced clinicians with prior training in ACLS. This course focus is "the next step" in ACLS training. ACLS – EP provides a stimulus for expert clinicians and practitioners to identify areas in resuscitation that deal with special circumstances. The goal of the ACLS EP Course is to improve outcomes in complex cardiovascular, respiratory and other (eg, metabolic, toxicological) emergencies by expanding on core ACLS guidelines and encouraging critical thinking and decision-making strategies. Through instruction and active participation in case-based scenarios, learners enhance their skills in the differential diagnosis and treatment of prearrest, arrest and postarrest patients.

Required Text: All participants are REQUIRED to have the 2013 American Heart Association ACLS- Experienced Provider Manual (item no. 90-1075). If at all possible, candidates should also bring the 2010 Guidelines Handbook or standard ACLS Provider Manual to the class.
