

Danville Area Training Center SUPER CE Weekend

The Danville Area Training Center is looking forward to hosting our Third Annual Super CE Weekend On February 7th, 8th, and 9th. All area agencies are invited to attend.

Since we are offering Continuing Education rather than strictly following a “refresher program”, there are a number of topics that will be presented that include Objectives from the EMT curriculum as well as Objectives from the ALS curriculums. That way, we will be able to offer a number of CAT 1 CEU’s to ALS providers as well. The Syllabus for the weekend is included as an attachment.

Each day will run from 8am until 5pm and will be broken down into one-hour segments. We will provide all 24 Category 1 CE’s required for EMT recertification. Each class will begin on the hour, so it is important to be on time. If you are late, you will not be eligible for that hour of CE.

Traditionally, we have instructors from the Danville Life Saving Crew, the Danville Fire Department, Regional One EMS, Danville Regional Medical Center, and the Danville Area Training Center who provide most of the instruction. These instructors have always given of their time, so there will be no cost to the participants!

CE’s are more critical than ever, especially for those who wish to keep their National Registry certifications up to date! While a change is anticipated, NREMT currently requires 72 hours of Continuing Education every two (2) years! There is no better time than the “dead of winter” to knock out some of these CE requirements!
