Statement of Need:

FCDPS is a rural combination career and volunteer system with six career stations-staffed 24/7/365 , one part time station (staffed 7 days/wk 0800-2000-this is an additional 24 hrs per week) and one volunteer agency (covering 60% of their BLS calls between 1800-0600). The same amount of territory was previously covered by 10 active volunteer rescue squads and supplemented by career staff. The amount of calls, population, and acuity of patients utilizing 911 has increased significantly. With the increased acuity, decreased volunteers and further need to go outside the county to specialty hospitals, the system is often reaching out to other agencies to listen out or assist. Our staff are also being requested to meet outside our jurisdiction

agencies for mutual aid. Our local hospital is a community hospital and quite often diverts EMS units to other hospitals adding 25-30 miles and one or more hours to the run.
